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### **Brief about GyanSetu program:**

GyanSetu program is being implemented in Harringtonganj block of district Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh. Total 6 GyanSetu centres are established as Community Education centres. This program work to address the issues of primary education for marginalized families' children and mainstream to children in primary education. This Initiative work on bridging the gaps of learning by establishing Community owned education center and mainstreaming to drop-out, irregular, and slow-learner and out of schools' children in schools. Focus beneficiaries of the project are Drop-out, out of schools, irregular children from low income communities will be primary beneficiary of the project. Project also work with parents, teachers to address the issues of quality education.

This program engages to the local volunteer as teachers to conduct classes for the children through creative and joy learning process: learning games, using Teaching Learning Material-TLM, creative exercise, debate. Teachers teach to children on their school curriculum with focus subject: Hindi, Math, English, GK and Moral/value based education.

Overall goal and objective of proposed project is "bridging the gaps of learning among children of marginalized communities and mainstreaming to them in public schools" through Establishing community education center, helping to transition among slow-learner, drop-out and out of school's children into formal schools along with providing tutoring support.

### **Major activities conducted**

#### **1. Establishment of GyanSetu Kendra/Center in 6 villages:**

A meeting conducted in communities about establishing the GyanSetu Kendra and to address the needs of drop-out, irregular and marginalized children for mainstreaming their education. A community space has been decided in each 6 villages to run the classes. Volunteer teachers from each 6 villages did a mapping to register the children with Kendra. SATHI team with the support of Volunteer teachers worked to assess the basic stationary and infrastructure needs to for setting-up the centres. As per requirement of centres materials provided to them. Opening of the centres was done by the community persons. Established centre is managing by the community leaders as well by the volunteer teachers. SATHI works with them to address the needs of training, facilitation, material and other monetary supports.

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## 2. Training cum workshop with Volunteer Teachers:

3 days training cum workshop conducted with volunteers' teachers on teaching methodology, creative and joyful learning processes. In this event teacher developed different Teaching Learning Materials, puzzles, Game activity, extra circular activities, joyful and creative teaching methods and how to manage the different level children at same time. This 3 days event supported to the volunteer teachers on teaching methods as well engaging with children. Orientation sessions also conducted with volunteers teachers on Child Rights, Good touch-bad touch, do's and don'ts for centres activity and conducting the regular learning assessment.

## 3. Regular conduction of classes:

Gyan Setu Kendra is being conducted in 6 villages of Harringtonganj block, Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh. Total 212 children (F-87,M-125) are taking education in their village. Overall objective of these centres are to mainstream the primary education of children in schools. Volunteers' teachers conduct 2-3 hours class on regular basis in community space. Teachers teach to children on their school curriculum with focus subject: Hindi, Math, English, GK and Moral/value based education. Regular orientations of parents are also being conducted on supporting to children in education, Gender behaviour and Child Rights.
